



Payment Policy and Fundraising

Player Fees

Player fees help Kootenai Thunder operate by contributing towards expenses incurred while running the sports program. This includes, but is not limited to, paying referees, gym rental, and buying and replacing equipment and uniforms. Players will not be allowed to play until at least half of the fee is paid. You will have until halfway through the season to pay the second half. If this is not paid by halfway through the season, your child will not play until the full amount is paid. Player fees are nonrefundable after the middle of the season for a particular sport. 50% may be refunded after the second game. We are always willing to work a payment plan out with you. Uniform Deposit

In order to make sure uniforms are returned in good order and a timely fashion, we require a \$40 deposit per uniform. We accept this in the form of a **check** that we will hold and not cash unless the uniform is not returned or if the uniform is returned in poor condition. **Please write a separate \$40 check for each uniform.** When uniforms are returned in good order, your check will be returned to you. If you do not have checks, please contact Diedre (208-610-4542). **Uniforms will not be issued until the deposit is given to the treasurer.**
